How do we deal with struggles in the 'Promised Land'?</li> <li>□ Gen.41:47-49: First, when the price of grain crashed, Joseph bought up &amp; stored away their grain. How does 'supply &amp; demand' affect the price of goods?</li> <li>□ v.14: Second, when famine struck, Joseph sold their grain back to them at a much higher price. Is it OK that some profit from human catastrophes/ natural disasters?</li> <li>□ v.15-17: Third, Joseph went after their livestock. What would this have done to their recovery/ future development?</li> <li>□ v.18-20: Fourth, Joseph went after their land. What does it mean to be repossessed/ dispossessed?</li> <li>□ v.21: Fifth, Jospeh went after their humanity, making them slaves.
