Early Bird Prayer is on Tuesday 16th July, drop-in anytime between 6.30 - 8am, grab a light breakfast, pray and go!



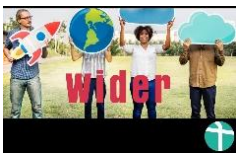
Club Tuesday: The next meeting will be on 16th July at 11.30am. Any queries please contact Norma Scott.

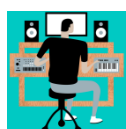
Looking ahead
