Deacons: The next meeting will take place on Thursday 5th September at 7.30pm in the lounge.



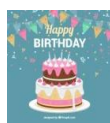
Ladies' Group Prayer Breakfast: The next meeting will be on Saturday 7th September from 9am – 10:30am. Any queries please contact Judith Miller.
