As you know, the UK Government has asked *everyone* to take unprecedented measures to help combat the serious threat of Coronavirus. Those most at risk are older people, those with underlying health conditions, and those who are pregnant.

It's not just that we don't want to catch Covid-19, it's more that, without realising it, we don't want to be the one who passes it on to others. Love God and love others as you love yourself.

It's right that we as a church, and each of us as individuals, follow the clear Government, medical and scientific call to create and maintain social distance, reducing the rate of spread.

Therefore, with immediate effect, we have suspended ALL and any on-site activities, clubs, and meetings at our Chester Road church building. For now, there will be no Sunday services. No-one knows how long this will last for.

However, this does <u>NOT</u> mean the #GrowingCommunity that is Chester Road Baptist Church has stopped. We haven't! We've always known Church is not a building, it's the people. Now, over the next few months, we're all going to demonstrate this. For the time being, we will no longer *attend* church. Instead we will BE and DO church together #GrowingCommunity!

We recently explored a few of the 50+ *One Another* passages. It's more important than ever for us each to pray for *one another*, care for *one another*, encourage *one another*... "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love *one another*." John 13:35

We must each respect and maintain social distance between *one another*. Yet, social *distance* need not mean social *isolation*. Let's find ways to connect with *one another*. For example:

- Telephone people (and not just the same few). Let them hear your voice, and you theirs.
- Doorstep visits, maintaining safe 2 metre/ 6 foot+ distance
- Chat to neighbours over the garden fence.
- Use Skype or FaceTime to 'meet' with others.

Over the coming days and weeks, we'll have to use different ways to communicate together. Do we have your email address? Do we have your mobile number? Tell us anyway!
