

Salt & Light



For today's activity, we're going to make a lighthouse!

Here's what you'll need:

- paper rolls (empty toilet rolls)
- blue paint for the sky
- blue paint for the sea/ocean
- white paint
- red paint
- black marker
- yellow paper or yellow paint
- paint brushes
- glue
- pencil



Draw a curved shape on one side of the paper (to mark the island) and a straight line from one side of the paper to the other for the horizon.

Paint (or colour) the sky, the sea and the island.

Take the toilet paper roll and cut it in half as shown on the image.



Leave one half as it is and cut the other half as shown in the image.



Trim the sides a little as shown on the image.



Paint the larger half of the paper roll. Paint strips of red and white. Set aside and let dry.

Paint the smaller one white. Set aside and let dry. Once it's dry, draw details such as windows with a black marker.

Apply glue to the edges of each roll, stick the red and white onto the paper first and then stick the white one above.

Cut a "light beam" out of yellow paper and glue it onto the paper. Alternatively, you could paint it on.
