


Sorry

Up and Down the Tree Craft


For this craft you will need:

Zacchaeus, green paper or crayons, yarn, scissors, hole punch, crayons, glue and tape
To prepare, draw or make a tree! Cut out a Zacchaeus figure. Punch a hole near the top of the trees. Cut yarn into approximately 7" lengths. Attach the tree to the craft stick with glue. Tape Zacchaeus to the yarn, thread the yarn through the hole in the tree, and tie the yarn off in the back to move Zacchaeus up and down the tree.






Zacchaeus Crossword
