Discuss	<ul> <li>□ Why are some words considered acceptable 'in polite company' and others not? Who decides?</li> <li>□ When have you done or received something that was an undeserved blessing?</li> </ul>

Explore	<ul> <li>□ v.1: Why was Paul so</li> <li>□ v.2: Why were some established leaders insisting that new converts must be circumcised if they are to be acceptable to God? What expectations/ requirements do we sometimes place on new people that have more to do with our traditions/ history than God's agenda?</li> <li>□ v.3: Why/ how do those new to faith sometimes have more spiritual insight (albeit, intuitively) than more long-established believers?</li> <li>□ v.4-6: What was it about Paul's story that meant he really understood and was shaped by God's grace?</li> <li>□ v.7: When we talk of God's 'grace', what do we mean? Why can grace not be earnt? Why do we sometimes struggle with the notion of 'grace'?</li> <li>□ v.8: Was Paul justified in using such strong language/ 'choice' slang - translated as 'garbage' (NIV/ GNT) or 'dung' (KJV) - to oppose those who were suggesting God's grace-alone was insufficient?</li> <li>□ v.10: How are we changed by Christ's life, death, and resurrection? Why would happen if we tried to follow just Christ's life (role model), death (martyr), OR resurrection (superstition)? Both/and, not either/or.</li> <li>□ v.12: Why/ how is grace on-going process, not just a one-off event?</li> <li>□ v13-14: What is the prize you are pressing on towards?</li> </ul>		
Go further	□ Read Romans 6:1. Dr Martin Lloyd Jones famously said that unless your preaching of grace leads people to wonder if it therefore doesn't matter how they live, you haven't actually preached grace at all. What did he mean? Do you agree?
