| P Explore | v.1-2: What was the question Paul was answering? If God accepts/ forgives us, no matter, just because we are 'in Christ', is that v.3-4: Why is baptism so much more than just a ritual/ rite of passage? If you've been baptised, what was it like? How did you <i>feel</i> at the time? v.5-7: Why are we sometimes '<u>slaves</u> to sin'? To what extent does your 'old self' <i>feel</i> 'crucified with Christ'? v.8-10: Why does death have no 'mastery' over Christ? What about us? To what extent do you <i>feel</i> this? v.11: '<i>Count</i> yourselves' is an accounting reference. What is double-entry book-keeping? You bank statement tells if you are <i>either</i> in credit <i>or</i> in debit/ overdrawn. Imagine you are overdrawn and have no means to change this. How does living in debt feel? Then imagine you receive an unexpected gift that clears your debt/ puts you in credit? How do you then feel? But even if you didn't, what would be the <i>truth</i> of your finances? Why is Paul saying we were <i>all</i> once 'overdrawn' with God? Why is this NOT about what <i>we</i> do or <i>feel</i>? How does this <i>truth</i> help when we <i>feel</i> broken, cut off from God, or full of shame? Or when we <i>feel</i> puffed up with pride, ego, or religion? Why do some Christians say they're 'saved by <i>faith</i>' but then try to 'live by <i>law</i>'? Why do they need to their spiritual accounts? v.12-14: If we are 'in Christ', why will we find ourselves not 'going back'? | | | |
