Start	☐ When have you looked at the niç	ght sky and thought, WOW!
Discuss	 □ Earth is in a solar system with our star, the sun, & 8 other planets. There are 200-400 billion solar systems in our galaxy, the Milky Way. There are 100+ billion galaxies What thoughts/ feelings/ beliefs does this stimulate in you? □ On the one hand, NASA says, despite the scale of the Cosmos/ universe, each one of us is totally unique. Are they right? Do you believe it? □ On the other hand, can the scale of the Cosmos leave us feeling lost, even invisible? How? Why? □ Why do we sometimes feel it is God who is invisible?

Explore	□ v.15: Want to know what God is like? Look at Jesus! What was Jesus like? What did He do? What qualities/ character did He display? So, what does Jesus' life show us God is like? □ v.16: Given the scale of the Cosmos, what does this say about Christ? Read Genesis 1:1 and John 1:1-3. To what extent are YOU "all things"? What difference does/ could it make to your life that you were created through Him and for Him? □ v.17: Why is it so hard sometimes to keep our 'stuff' together? How is Jesus the glue that holds all things (inc, us) together? □ v.18: Why is Jesus the 'firstborn from among the dead? How does this explain why Jesus' death was not simply the result of back-stabbing Judas, Roman soldiers, scheming Religious Elite, slimy Pilate? □ v.19: What is the 'fulness of God'? What difference did that make to Jesus? And to us now who are 'in Christ'? Read again start of v.18. Whether we believe, feel or deserve it, what does this mean for our gatherings as church? □ v.20: How does Christ reconcile all things? Why do we need reconciling, and to who/ what?	
Go further	 ☐ If the Universe is continuing to expand, with new planets, stars and solar systems, what does this say about God as Creator? ☐ As well as Creation, why is God also in the business of re-creation? Why is Christ sometimes referred to as 'the Second Adam'? 1 Corinthians 15:45-49.
