Discuss	<ul> <li>□ Is there a difference between <i>reading</i> the Bible and <i>studying</i> the Bible?</li> <li>□ What adjectives (describing words) do you associate with the Bible?</li> <li>□ Why are we still gaining new/ fresh perspectives on the Bible?</li> <li>□ How has your understanding of the Bible or a passage changed over time?</li> <li>□ How can you tell if Garry, with 2 Rs and 2 teeth, live-streaming from his basement in Tennessee, is a good source of Bible wisdom, knowledge and understanding?</li> </ul>

Explore	v.1: What are we to accept? Why accept the whole of the Bible/ all Scripture  (2 Timothy 3:16), not just parts of it? Why is memorizing Scripture helpful? For example, Psalm 119:11. What, if any, verses have you memorised?  v.2: Who do we tune in to/ dial up when reading the Bible? See 1 Corinthians 2.  What does it mean to apply ourselves, when reading the Bible? What tips do you have for doing this?  v.3: Why can understanding the Bible sometimes be a struggle? How do you feel if/ when you don't understand something in the Bible? How has your understanding changed over time?  v.4: Imagine you know you're missing something. You search high & low for it. Eventually, you find it. How does it make you feel? Why is understanding the Bible like finding treasure?  v.5: What were all the verbs in v.1-4? Why is understanding the Bible conditional on us accepting, memorizing, asking, struggling, searching, and digging?  v.6: What is wisdom? Knowledge? Understanding?
