Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much money does Chester Road Baptist Church need?

We'd like to do so much more mission and ministry. To run all our activities, employ our staff, and operate our buildings, our total budget is approximately £340,000 a year. That's approx:

- = £28,300 a month
- = £ 6,500 a week (or per Sunday)
- = £ 930 a day

2. Does Chester Road Baptist practise what it preaches about giving?

Yes! We are committed to giving 15% of all our donation income to fund mission & ministry and beyond ourselves: BMS World Mission in the Republic of Chad (5%), Baptist Home Mission (5%), and our partner church, Timberley Lane Baptist Church (5%).

3. Can I change the amount I give through Standing Order?

Yes! People's income goes up and down. To increase or decrease your Standing Order simply inform your bank and, ideally, the Church Office.

How is Chester Road Baptist Church funded?

We rely on the generous giving of all those that count 'Chester Road' as their spiritual home, as well as from those that use our facilities/ services.

Being a Baptist church, we are totally responsible for all our own costs: employing our staff; maintaining our buildings; funding our many church & community activities.

Why might I give?

People give to Chester Road Baptist Church for many different reasons:

- Many give as an act of worship and spiritual discipline.
 They seek to be disciples of Christ, submitting everything they have to God.
- Others give because the Bible has much to say about living generously, giving and the importance of valuing your church.
- Some give because they especially appreciate our work with young people and children, and in the wider community.
- Others give because it is rewarding to do something good with money. Everyone can experience the joy of giving.

How much should I give?

Each person should give according to their means and faith.

A core group of 'Chester Roaders' give 10% of their 'pay slip' income ('tithe') to the mission & ministry of Chester Road Baptist Church. Many others are working towards this level.

They appreciate the difference their giving makes to the lives of people: young and old, Christians and non-religious, in and beyond Chester Road.

We encourage responsible giving. No-one should feel under any pressure to give. Any gift, big or small, is wonderful. It is healthy to review your personal finances on a regular basis to ensure your giving is affordable and in proportion to your income. It may need to go up or down.

How well used is my giving?

The Trustees (elected Deacons) ensure strict financial safeguards are in place for good management of the church's finances. Chester Road Baptist Church is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (N° 1201208). Our accounts are independently examined each year and available online at CharityCommission.gov.uk ('Search the charity register')

How can I make my giving go further?

If you pay income tax or capital gains tax, please complete a Gift Aid declaration so the church can reclaim the tax. You only need do this once to cover all present and future gifts (as well as those in the past four years).

For example, if you pay UK tax at 20% and 'Gift Aid' £100 to Chester Road, we will receive £125 in total. What's more, if you pay higher rate tax you can claim extra relief on your giving through Self Assessment – legitimately reducing your own personal tax liability.

How and when can I give?

1. Make a regular gift by Standing Order - it helps us and you plan ahead

Having decided what to give, most give monthly by Standing Order. This is secure, easy to organise, and helps both you and us to budget better.
