Who was responsible for Jesus's death?: Religious elite, Romans, Judas, us, Satan, Jesus, God...? <input type="checkbox"/> v.3-5 : What did Jesus <i>know</i> ? What can <i>we</i> also know? How real does that feel? How might Jesus' <i>knowing</i> have enabled Him to wash feet? How does our <i>knowing</i> also enable us to serve others? Why was Jesus' action so symbolic? What else was Jesus doing? <input type="checkbox"/> v.6-8 : Why was Peter so appalled? Why could he not square Jesus as 'Lord' and Jesus as 'foot washer'? Why does it sometimes require <i>our</i> humility to accept Christ's <i>humility</i> ? <input type="checkbox"/> v.9 : Was Peter still missing the point? (physical cleanliness). Or, was Peter going all-in to accept all that Christ has to offer? <input type="checkbox"/> v.10-12 : By washing our 'dirt' how does Jesus become 'dirt'? Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 . Why was Judas' betrayal more than surface-level? Where did it come from? Read Luke 6:45 . <input type="checkbox"/> v.12-17 : What kind of Lord was Jesus? Read Mark 10:42-45 . How does Jesus call us to do the same for others? What happens when we perceive they are 'dirtier' than us? How do we avoid using acts of service to boost our own ego/pride/ power?
